

ORDINANCE NO. 1

AN ORDINANCE PERMITTING MAYOR TO MAKE TEMPORARY APPOINTMENT TO OFFICE IN CITY OF STILWELL, OKLAHOMA, IN CASE OF EMERGENCY, SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL OF COUNCIL OF CITY OF STILWELL, OKLAHOMA, AT THEIR NEXT REGULAR MEETING.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF STILWELL, OKLAHOMA:

1. That the Mayor of the City of Stilwell, Oklahoma, be and is empowered and authorized to make temporary appointment to any office, whether appointive or elective, of the City of Stilwell, Oklahoma, in case of death, resignation, disqualification, removal or otherwise, subject to approval of the City Council of the City of Stilwell, Oklahoma, at its next regular meeting thereafter.

2. For the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist by reason whereof this Ordinance shall be in effect from and after its passage and approval.
