

ORDINANCE NO. 22

AN ORDINANCE MAKING IT A MISDEMEANOR FOR A PERSON TO BE UNDER THE INFLUENCE OF INTOXICATING LIQUOR WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF STILWELL, PROVIDING A PENALTY THEREFOR; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF STILWELL:

SECTION 1. That it is hereby made a misdemeanor for any person to be found within the corporate limits of the City of Stilwell in a drunken or intoxicated condition.

SECTION 2. That any person found within the corporate limits of the City of Stilwell, in a drunken or intoxicated condition shall, upon conviction thereof, be punished by a fine and costs of not less than \$1.00 and not more than \$19.95.

SECTION 3. Whereas an immediate necessity exists; therefore, for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist by reason whereof this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication.
