

ORDINANCE NO. 150

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE DAMAGING OR CUTTING OF ANY OF THE STREETS OR ALLEYS WITHIN THE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF STILWELL, OKLAHOMA, WITHOUT HAVING FIRST OBTAINED A PERMIT TO DO SO; PROVIDING FOR A BOND TO SECURE THE REPAIR OF SAID STREETS AND ALLEYS; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STILWELL, OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. That from and after the date of the passage of this Ordinance, it shall be unlawful for any person, firm, company or corporation within the City of Stilwell, Oklahoma, to cut, remove or in any way damage the City streets or alleyways or cross the same with any water line, sewer line, gas line, electrical line or cable line or any kind of nature, without having first obtained a written permit from the City Clerk of Stilwell, Oklahoma, and after having first given a bond to insure the repair of said City streets or alleys; said bond to be given to the City of Stilwell, Oklahoma, in the office of the City Clerk and being in the amount sufficient to repair the cut or damage to said streets as approximated by the City Superintendent of the City of Stilwell, Oklahoma.

SECTION 2. WHEREAS, it being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public health, peace and safety of the City of Stilwell and the inhabitants thereof that the provisions of this Ordinance be put into full force and effect, an emergency is hereby declared to exist by reason thereof, and this Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
