

ORDINANCE NO. 177

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE PASSING OF SCHOOL BUSES EXHIBITING CAUTION LIGHTS OR STOP SIGNS BY MOTOR VEHICLES.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF STILWELL, OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. That from and after the passage and approval of this Ordinance, it shall be unlawful for any motor vehicle of any kind or nature, including motorcycles, to pass any school bus within the limits of the City of Stilwell, Oklahoma, while said school bus is exhibiting caution lights or stop signs or is in the process of stopping to unload school children.

SECTION 2. That any person violating the terms and provisions of this Ordinance shall be punished by a fine of not to exceed Thirty Dollars (\$30.00), plus costs.

SECTION 3. For the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist by reason whereof this Ordinance shall be in effect from and after its passage and approval.
