

ORDINANCE NO. 178

AN ORDINANCE SETTING CLOSING HOURS FOR ALL TAVERNS LOCATED WITHIN THE CITY OF STILWELL, OKLAHOMA.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF STILWELL, OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. That from and after the date hereof, all taverns who sell beer for on-premises consumption shall close from 2:00 a.m. on Sunday morning until 7:00 a.m. on Monday morning and that, during said times, no sales shall be made on premises and no persons shall be allowed within said premises, except the license holder and his employees.

SECTION 2. Any person or persons violating the terms and provisions of this Ordinance shall be punished by fines not to exceed Three Hundred Dollars (\$300.00), inclusive of cost, for each offense.

SECTION 3. The health, peace and safety of the citizens of Stilwell, Oklahoma, being involved herein, an emergency is declared, and said Ordinance shall be in full force and effect after its passage and publication.
