

ORDINANCE NO. 180

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR FINES AND PENALTIES FOR DRIVING A MOTOR VEHICLE AT A SPEED IN EXCESS OF THE SPEED LIMIT.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STILWELL, OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. That it shall be unlawful for any person to drive a motor vehicle as is defined by Ordinance No. 23 of the City of Stilwell, Oklahoma, in excess of a lawful speed limit as is posted or as is set by ordinance.

SECTION 2. Any person convicted of violating the terms and provisions of this Ordinance shall be fined as follows:

Up to 10 MPH over speed limit.....	\$20.00, plus costs;
From 11 MPH to 20 MPH over speed limit.....	\$30.00, plus costs;
From 21 MPH to 30 MPH over speed limit.....	\$40.00, plus costs;
From 31 MPH to 40 MPH over speed limit.....	\$50.00, plus costs;
From 41 MPH upward.....	\$60.00, plus costs;

SECTION 3. That all ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4. WHEREAS, an immediate necessity exists; therefore, for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist by reason whereof this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
