

ORDINANCE NO. 209

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE ANNEXATION OF CERTAIN PROPERTY TO THE CITY OF STILWELL, OKLAHOMA, AND CHANGING THE CITY'S BOUNDARY TO INCLUDE SUCH TERRITORY, AND DESIGNATING SUCH TERRITORY AS THE STILWELL ELEMENTARY SCHOOL ADDITION TO THE CITY OF STILWELL, OKLAHOMA.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STILWELL, OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. That the following described real property situate adjacent to and abutting upon the present corporate limits of the City of Stilwell, Oklahoma, shall be annexed to and become a part of the City of Stilwell, Oklahoma, to wit:

A tract of land lying in and being a part of the S/2, NW.4, SE/4 and a part of the E/2, SW/4, SE/4 of Section 34, Township 16 North, Range 25 East, more particularly described as follows, to wit: Beginning at a point on the East boundary and 402.25 feet South of the Northeast corner of said S/2, NW?4, SE/4; thence North 87 degrees 55' West along the South boundary of Leisure Lane Subdivision to the Town of Stilwell, Oklahoma, 336.27 feet; thence South 89 degrees 56' West along the South boundary of Nancy Addition to the Town of Stilwell, Oklahoma, 434.00 feet; thence South 12 degrees 00' East, 25.60 feet; thence South 26 degrees 12' East, 357.62 feet; thence South 25 degrees 23' East, 337.40 feet; thence South 20 degrees 46' East, 327.24 feet; thence South 78 degrees 46' East along the North boundary of First Baptist Church Addition to the Town of Stilwell, Oklahoma, 353.53 feet to a point on the East boundary of said E/2, SW/4, SE/4; thence North 0 degrees 02' West along the East boundary of said E/2, SW/4, SE/4 and along the West boundary of Allen Addition to the Town of Stilwell, Oklahoma, 1013.87 feet to the point of beginning, containing 12.13 acres,

a plat of which property is attached hereto and made a part hereof as though described herein.

SECTION 2. That the real property herein described shall be designated as the **STILWELL ELEMENTARY SCHOOL ADDITION** to the City of Stilwell, Oklahoma, and the boundaries of said City are hereby changed to correspond to the legal description first above given.

SECTION 3. That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4. WHEREAS, an immediate necessity exists; therefore, for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist by reason whereof this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
