WHEREAS, Trash Service by the City of Stilwell is a purchased service; and

WHEREAS, the health and safety of both the citizens of Stilwell and municipal employees is of paramount importance; and

WHEREAS, it is the opinion of this Council that adequate guidelines are essential for the efficient and effective fulfillment of the purpose of the Stilwell Sanitation Department,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STILWELL, OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1 - DEFINITIONS:

"Residential pick-up" is defined as curbside pick-up of bagged or boxed trash only. This does not include use of a city dumpster.

"Commercial base pick-up" is defined as curbside pick-up for a business of bagged or boxed trash only. This does not include usage of a city dumpster.

"Dumpster rental" is defined as use of a particular dumpster by the customer paying the rental fee.

"Illegal dumping" is defined as, but not limited to, putting trash in or around a dumpster not rented by that person or adding trash to the curbside pick-up of another city customer.

SECTION 2 - ALL UTILITY CUSTOMERS TO HAVE TRASH PICK-UP

All City Utilities customers living within the legal boundaries of the City of Stilwell shall be required to have trash pickup as a health and safety requirement.

SECTION 3 - All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby cancelled and repealed.


