

ORDINANCE NO. 140

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING BOUNDARIES OF BRUNER ADDITION TO THE CITY OF STILWELL, OKLAHOMA.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STILWELL, OKLAHOMA:

THAT WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Stilwell, Oklahoma, by Ordinance No. 102, has annexed certain real property into the limits of the City of Stilwell, Oklahoma, in Ordinance No. 102; and

WHEREAS, the legal description of said property contained in Ordinance No. 102 contains certain variances from the actual location of the property; and

WHEREAS, it is the intent of this Ordinance to properly define the boundaries and limits of said Bruner Addition and to retain the said subdivision as a part of the City of Stilwell, Oklahoma, from and after the date of its original passage:

SECTION 1. That the following described real property situated adjacent to and abutting upon the present corporate limits of the City of Stilwell, Oklahoma, shall be annexed to and become part of the City of Stilwell, Oklahoma, to wit:

A subdivision of the North 396.00 feet of the W/2, NW/4, NE/4, NE/4 of Section 34, Township 16 North, Range 25 East, and the North 5.00 feet of the East 989.08 feet of the NE/4, NE/4 of Section 34, Township 16 North, Range 25 East, and the West 5.00 feet of the South 1179.00 feet of the North 1576.00 feet of the NE/4, NE/4 of Section 34, Township 16 North, Range 25 East,

a plat of which said property is hereto attached and made a part hereof as though described herein.

SECTION 2. That the real estate herein described shall continue to be designated as the **BRUNER ADDITION** to the City of Stilwell, Oklahoma, and that the legal descriptions contained in Ordinance No. 102, which are incorporated by reference within this Ordinance, be, and the same are hereby, set aside; and, from and after the date of the passage of this Ordinance, the said Bruner Addition shall be comprised of that property hereinabove described.

SECTION 3 WHEREAS, an immediate necessity exists; therefore, for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist by reason whereof this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
