

ORDINANCE NO. 159

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING FEES AND CHARGES FOR THE AMBULANCE SERVICE OF THE CITY OF STILWELL, OKLAHOMA; AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT THEREWITH; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STILWELL, OKLAHOMA.

THAT from and after the date of the passage of this Ordinance, the fees and charges for ambulance service provided by the City of Stilwell, Oklahoma, shall be as follows, to wit:

Base Charge	\$75.00
Emergency Run	75.00
Night Run	75.00
Mileage	2.00 per mile
Supplies	20.00
Oxygen	10.00

provided, that no additional mileage shall be charged for runs under 10 miles.

THAT all ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

WHEREAS, an immediate necessity exists; therefore, for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist by reason whereof this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
