

ORDINANCE NO. 182

AN ORDINANCE LEVYING THE SUM OF \$5.00 ON EACH MUNICIPAL FINE, SAID AMOUNT TO BE PAYABLE INTO THE LAW ENFORCEMENT TRAINING FUND.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STILWELL, OKLAHOMA:

THAT from and after the date of the passage of this Ordinance, there shall be levied on each Municipal fine the sum of \$5.00, which said sum shall go to the Law Enforcement Officers Training Fund, said sums to be forwarded to the appropriate State agency. All ordinances in conflict herewith are repealed.

WHEREAS, an immediate necessity exists; therefore, for the preservation of public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist by reason whereof this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
