

ORDINANCE NO. 197

AN ORDINANCE MAKING IT UNLAWFUL FOR FAILURE TO APPEAR BEFORE MUNICIPAL COURT UPON CITATION AND FAILURE TO PAY FINE AND COSTS ASSESSED BY MUNICIPAL COURT; PROVIDING PENALTY; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL:

SECTION 1. It shall be unlawful for any person to fail to appear in response to a citation, without good cause, and failure to appear shall be in indirect contempt of court.

SECTION 2. It shall be unlawful for any person to fail, without good cause, to pay fines and costs deferred by agreement of the Municipal Judge. Upon so failing, such person shall be guilty of indirect contempt of court.

SECTION 3. Any person who violates this Ordinance shall be assessed fine and costs not to exceed the sum of \$50.00 dollars, inclusive of costs.

SECTION 4. That, in order to preserve the public safety, health and peace, an emergency is hereby declared to exist by reason whereof this Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage and publication.
