

ORDINANCE NO. 207

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE ANNEXATION OF CERTAIN PROPERTY TO THE CITY OF STILWELL, OKLAHOMA, AND CHANGING THE CITY'S BOUNDARY TO INCLUDE SUCH TERRITORY, AND DESIGNATING SUCH TERRITORY AS THE SECOND MORTON ADDITION TO THE CITY OF STILWELL, OKLAHOMA.

SECTION 1. That the following described real property situate adjacent to and abutting upon the present corporate limits of the City of Stilwell, Oklahoma, shall be annexed to and become part of the City of Stilwell, Oklahoma, to wit:

Commencing at the Southwest corner of the SE/4, SE/4, NW/4 of Section 3, Township 15 North, Range 25 East, Adair County, Oklahoma, for the true point of beginning; thence North 00 degrees 02' 55" West for a distance of 658.84 feet; thence North 89 degrees 39' 26" East for a distance of 659.27 feet; thence South 00 degrees 02' 55" East for a distance of 508.84 feet; thence South 89 degrees 39' 26" West for a distance of 329.62 feet; thence South 00 degrees 02' 55" East for a distance of 150.00 feet; thence South 89 degrees 39' 26" West for a distance of 329.62 feet to the true point of beginning, containing 8.84 acres, more or less,

a plat of which said property is attached hereto and made apart hereof as thought described herein.

SECTION 2. That the real property herein described shall be designated as the **SECOND MORTON ADDITION** to the City of Stilwell, Oklahoma, and the boundaries of said City are hereby changed to correspond to the legal description first above given.

SECTION 3. That all ordinances or parts or ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4. WHEREAS, an immediate necessity exists; therefore, for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist by reason whereof this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
