ORDINANCE NO. 210

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE BUILDING CODE OF THE CITY OF STILWELL, OKLAHOMA; PRESCRIBING FEES PAYABLE TO THE CITY CLERK-TREASURER BEFORE PERMITS ARE ISSUED UNDER SAID CODE; PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR VIOLATION; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT THEREWITH; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF STILWELL, OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. From and after the effective date of this Ordinance the following fees shall be payable to the City Clerk-Treasurer for all residential and business construction of every king and nature, including remodeling and alteration of buildings or structures for the purpose of defraying inspection of the building including water, sewer and electrical, to wit: A minimum fee of \$50.00 or the greater sum of the following:

SECTION 2. Any person, firm or corporation who shall violate may of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be deemed guilty of an offense and, upon conviction thereof, shall be fined a sum not to exceed fine and costs of \$75.00 and, in addition, shall not be entitled to obtain or receive any utilities furnished by the City until obtaining such building permit.

SECTION 3. All ordinances or parts thereof in conflict with the provisions hereof are hereby expressly repealed.

SECTION 4. For the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist by reason whereof this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval.
