

ORDINANCE NO. 24

AN ORDINANCE FIXING THE SALARY OF THE CITY TREASURER OF THE CITY OF STILWELL, AND THE SALARY OF THE CITY CLERK OF THE CITY OF STILWELL: AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT THEREWITH.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF STILWELL:

Section 1. That from and after the passage and approval of this ordinance the salary of the City Treasurer of the City of Stilwell, shall be, and the same is hereby fixed in the sum of Eighteen Hundred, Dollars, (\$1800.00) per year payable monthly.

Section 2. That the salary of the City Clerk, shall be, and the same is hereby fixed in the sum of Six Hundred, Dollars (\$600.00) per year payable monthly.

Section 3. That ~~all~~ ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 4. That this ordinance shall be in full force and take effect from and after its passage, approval and publication as required by law.
