

ORDINANCE NO. 257

AN ORDINANCE TO PERMIT AGRICULTURE USE OF ALL PREMISES NOT PLATTED INTO LOTS AND BLOCKS WITHIN EITHER ORIGINAL OR ANNEXED CORPORATE LIMITS; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT THEREWITH; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of Stilwell, Oklahoma:

SECTION 1.

All premises within the corporate limits, either original or annexed, shall be usable for agriculture purposes contrary to any other existing ordinance. When such property is platted into lots and blocks the use of such property shall be governed by the then existing zoning ordinances.

SECTION 2.

All ordinances in conflict herewith is hereby repealed.

SECTION 3.

WHEREAS, an immediate necessity exists, therefore, for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist by reason whereof this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
