

ORDINANCE NO. 258

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 237 ALTERING CURFEW HOURS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council or Stilwell, Oklahoma:

SECTION 1. SECTION 1 OF ORDINANCE NO. 237 IS HEREBY AMENDED AS FOLLOWS:

It shall be unlawful for any person under the age of 18 years unless accompanied by a parent or lawful guardian to be and remain upon any street, avenue, alley, park or other public place within the city after the hour of 10:00 o'clock p.m. Sunday through Thursday and after the hour of 12:00 o'clock midnight Friday through Saturday. Any person guilty of violating this Ordinance shall pay a fine and costs not exceeding the sum of \$50.00.

SECTION 2. EMERGENCY CLAUSE.

WHEREAS, an immediate necessity exists, therefore, for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist by reason whereof this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
