

ORDINANCE NO. 290

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING PARKING OF CERTAIN VEHICLES ON DIVISION STREET, EXCEPTING COMMERCIAL VEHICLES, PROVIDING FOR PENALTY; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Mayor and Council of the City of Stilwell, Oklahoma:

SECTION 1. Vehicles whose dimensions exceed three-quarter (3/4) ton extended cab pickups, are prohibited from parking on Division Street between Front Street and Sixth Street except commercial vehicles may park during business hours in connection with legitimate business interests.

SECTION 2. Anyone violating this ordinance shall be subject to a fine including costs of fifty dollars (\$50.00) and every prohibited vehicle found so parked shall be subject to impoundment.

SECTION 3. WHEREAS, an immediate necessity exists therefor, for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist by reason whereof this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
