

ORDINANCE NO. 331

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 218 TO PROHIBIT THE KEEPING OF ROOSTERS WITHIN THE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF STILWELL, OKLAHOMA.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STILWELL, OKLAHOMA.

SECTION 1. That from and after the effective date of this ordinance, Article 4 or Ordinance No. 218, be and the same is hereby amended to add the language as follows, to wit:

SECTION 2. PROHIBITION AGAINST ROOSTERS IN CITY LIMITS

A. It shall be unlawful for any person to keep, maintain, sell or have in his possession or under his control within the corporate limits of the City of Stilwell, Oklahoma any rooster.

B. This ordinance does not apply to entertainment events approved by the City Council in advance.

C. Any person, firm or corporation violating any provision of this ordinance shall be subject to a fine as provided herein, and in addition, after written notice is given to the owner of any such rooster, the Mayor and Police Department are authorized to have the rooster removed from the City limits of Stilwell, Oklahoma and in addition to being an offense, such acts or omissions, as are prohibited in this section shall be a nuisance and may be abated accordingly by killing such rooster, after giving three days notice.


SECTION 3. That all other parts of said Ordinance shall remain the same and remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 4. That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

WHEREAS, an immediate necessity exists; therefore, for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist by reason whereof this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
