

ORDINANCE NO. 61

ORDINANCE FOR A VOLUNTEER FIRE DEPARTMENT WHICH HAS IN ITS EMPLOY NOT MORE THAN TWO FULL-TIME, SALARIED FIREMEN.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF STILWELL, OKLAHOMA:

That the Fire Department of Stilwell, Oklahoma, is a volunteer department which has in its employ not more than two full-time salaried firemen, and that it shall be comprised of not less than 12 nor more than 20 volunteer firemen.

For the purpose of this Ordinance, a volunteer fireman shall be considered as one who is enrolled as a member of the Fire Department and who serves in said capacity without receiving a regular salary.

All ordinances and parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.
