

ORDINANCE NUMBER 8

AN ORDINANCE REENACTING ORDINANCE NUMBER 2 REGULATING THE LEVYING AND COLLECTION OF A TAX ON CERTAIN SPECIFIED OCCUPATIONS AND REPEALING THE 6th PARAGRAPH THEREOF PERTAINING TO PENALTIES AND REENACTING THE SAME.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF STILWELL, OKLAHOMA:

I. That with the exception of paragraph 6 of said ordinance Number 2 the entire ordinance is hereby reenacted.

II. The 6th paragraph thereof is hereby repealed and is reenacted as follows: "That any person or persons who shall fail or refuse to comply with any of the above provisions shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and on conviction thereof shall be fined in any sum of not less than \$10.00 nor more than \$20.00 including costs and no penalty greater than \$20.00 including costs may be assessed against defendants, and that each day that said defendant or defendants neglect or refuse to comply with the same shall constitute a separate offense."


III. For the preservation of the public peace, health, and safety an emergency is hereby declared to exist by reason whereof this ordinance shall be in effect from and after its passage and approval.
