

ORDINANCE NO. 212

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE ANNEXATION OF CERTAIN PROPERTY TO THE CITY OF STILWELL, OKLAHOMA, AND CHANGING THE CITY'S BOUNDARY TO INCLUDE SUCH TERRITORY, AND DESIGNATING SUCH TERRITORY AS THE MARYETTA ELEMENTARY SCHOOL ADDITION TO THE CITY OF STILWELL, OKLAHOMA.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STILWELL, OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. That the following described real property situate adjacent to and abutting upon the present corporate limits of the City of Stilwell, Oklahoma, shall be annexed to and become part of the City of Stilwell, Oklahoma, to wit:

All that part of the W/2, SE/4, SE/4 lying West of U. S. Highway #59, less the South 417.42 feet of the West 104.23 feet thereof; and the NE/4, SE/4, SE/4, less the North 220.00 feet thereof; and the E/2, NW/4, SW/4, SE/4, less the North 220.00 feet thereof; and the S/2, SW/4, SE/4, less the South 417.42 feet of the East 939.42 feet and less the North 360.00 feet of the West 330.00 feet thereof, all in Section 22, Township 16 North, Range 25 East, and

The East 396.00 feet of the NW/4, NW/4, NE/4 of Section 27, Township 16 North, Range 25 East, and

Beginning at the Northwest corner of the E/2, NW/4, NE/4; thence South 208.75 feet; thence East 208.75 feet; thence North 208.75 feet; thence West 208.75 feet to the point of beginning in Section 27, Township 16 North, Range 25 East, and

The West 54.00 feet of the East 208.75 feet of the West 449.50 feet of the North 208.75 feet of the E/2, NW/4, NE/4 of Section 27, Township 16 North, Range 25 East, all in Adair County, Oklahoma, containing in all 34.3 acres, more or less,

a plat of which said property is attached hereto and made a part hereof as though described herein.

SECTION 2. That the real property herein described shall be designated as the **MARYETTA ELEMENTARY SCHOOL ADDITION** to the City of Stilwell, Oklahoma, and the boundaries of said City are hereby changed to correspond to the legal description first above given.

SECTION 3. That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4. WHEREAS, an immediate necessity exists; therefore, for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist by reason whereof this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
