

ORDINANCE NO. 213

AN ORDINANCE MAKING IT UNLAWFUL TO INTERFERE WITH UTILITY, TELEPHONE AND/OR CABLE LINES; PROVIDING A PENALTY; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF STILWELL, OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. INJURIES TO PIPES, WIRES, CABLES, APPURTENANCES AND APPENDAGES.

Every person who wilfully breaks, digs up or obstructs any pipes or mains for conducting gas, water or sewer or any works erected for supplying

buildings with gas, water or sewer or any appurtenances or appendages therewith connected to injures, cuts, breaks down or destroys any electric light wires, poles or appurtenances or any telephone or telegraph wires, cable television cables or appurtenances or taps any cable television system without permission shall be guilty of a violation and, upon conviction, be subject to penalty of \$50.00 fine, including costs.

SECTION 2. For the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist by reason where of this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval.
