

ORDINANCE NO. 224

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR PENALTY FOR VIOLATION OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF STILWELL, OKLAHOMA.

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of Stilwell, Oklahoma:

SECTION 1. That from and after the effective date of this ordinance the penalty for violation of ordinances of the City of Stilwell shall be a sum not exceeding One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) plus costs and all penalties in conflict herewith are hereby specifically amended.

SECTION 2. For the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist by reason whereof this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval.
