

ORDINANCE NO. 298

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE COLLECTION AND DISTRIBUTION OF BRUSH OR TREE LIMBS, APPLIANCES, FURNITURE AND OTHER SIMILAR REFUSE; FIXING A SPECIAL FEE FOR SUCH SERVICE; REQUIRING MANNER OF PAYMENT; ESTABLISHING A PENALTY FOR VIOLATION OF THE SAME; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the City of Stilwell, Oklahoma:

SECTION 1. From and after the effective date of this ordinance there shall be a fee for the collection and removal of brush and/or tree limbs in the sum of twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) per truck load or portion thereof to be paid not less than twenty-four (24) hours in advance of removal of the same.

SECTION 2. It shall be necessary that all patrons who request removal of brush and/or tree limbs must have the same cut into lengths of not more than four (4) feet. All such refuse herein described must be placed upon the alley or curb adjacent to the customer's property.

SECTION 3. The collection and removal of appliances such as refrigerators, deep freeze, hot water tank, stoves, etc. and furniture such as chairs, beds, divans, etc. shall be charged at the rate of one dollar (\$1.00) per item in advance. All fees herein provided shall be paid to the office of the City Clerk.

SECTION 4. The provisions of this ordinance as it pertains to the removal of brush and/or tree limbs does not apply to the removal of such items which have accumulated due to windstorms or other act of God.

SECTION 5. Any person, firm or corporation who fails to pay such fees herein provided in advance of the removal of such refuse covered by this ordinance shall be subject to fine and costs in a sum not in excess of one hundred eighteen dollars (&118.00).

SECTION 6. An immediate necessity exists and therefore, for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist by reason whereof this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after it's passage and approval.
