

ORDINANCE 401

AN ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH RULES AND RESTRICTIONS PERTAINING TO CITY-OWNED PROPERTY IN THE AREA DESIGNATED AS C. J. CARSON LAKE AND REPEALING ORDINANCE 333.

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STILWELL,
OKLAHOMA:**

SECTION 1:

The following rules and restrictions govern public use on and of the property of the City of Stilwell designated as C. J. Carson Lake:

1. Overnight camping is not permitted.
2. All boats operated on the lake must have a life preserver or life jacket for each person on board said boat.
3. No lifeguard will be present and swimming is discouraged.
4. Dumping of trash, refuse and debris is prohibited.
5. Private boat houses, ramps, docks and other facilities may not be constructed on C. J. Carson Lake.
6. Vandalism, theft and damage to city property is prohibited.
7. No person shall:
 - a. use language that is:
 - i. unseemly,
 - ii. obscene,
 - iii. offensive,
 - iv. threatening,
 - v. insulting,
 - vi. abusive
 - b. participate in a disorderly assemblage,
 - c. publicly appear nude or intoxicated,
 - d. disturb the peace of another or others by:
 - i. violent, obstreperous or improper conduct or carriage,
 - ii. loud or unusual noise,
 - iii. conducting themselves in a disorderly manner.
8. All motorized vehicles are required to stay on roads designated as open for public.
9. No livestock shall be allowed on the property.
10. The operation of boats with internal combustion engines on the lake is prohibited.
 - a. Only boats with electric motors may be operated on the lake.
11. All fishing-related activities shall comply with state law.
12. Tournament and Derby fishing shall be allowed with trolling motors only.
13. Any Tournament or Derby must be approved in advance by both the Stilwell City Council and the Stilwell Utility Board.

SECTION 2:

Violation of any portion of Section 1 shall result in fine or prosecution to the full extent of the law.

SECTION 3:


Ordinance 333 is hereby cancelled and repealed upon adoption of this Ordinance.


