

ORDINANCE NO. 125

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE ANNEXATION OF CERTAIN PROPERTY TO THE CITY OF STILWELL, OKLAHOMA, AND CHANGING THE CITY'S BOUNDARY TO INCLUDE SUCH TERRITORY AND DESIGNATING SUCH TERRITORY AS THE JOHNSON ADDITION TO THE CITY OF STILWELL, OKLAHOMA.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STILWELL, OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. That the following described real property situate adjacent to and abutting upon the present corporate limits of the City of Stilwell, Oklahoma, shall be annexed to and become part of the City of Stilwell, Oklahoma, to wit:

A subdivision of that portion of the W/2, SE/4, NE/4 of Section 34, Township 16 North, Range 25 East, Adair County, Oklahoma, described as follows: Beginning at the Northwest corner of said W/2, SE/4, NE/4; thence South 0 degrees 01' East, 185.00 to the true point of beginning; thence South 0 degrees 01' East, 130.00 feet, thence South 89 degrees 52' East, 210.00 feet; thence North 0 degrees 01' West, 45.00 feet; thence South 89 degrees 52' East, 240.00 feet; thence South 0 degrees 01' East, 166.00 feet; thence South 89 degrees 52' East, 199.35 feet; thence North 0 degrees 01' West, 376.00 feet; thence North 89 degrees 52' West, 439.00 feet; thence South 0 degrees 01' East, 125.00 feet, thence North 89 degrees 52' West, 220.00 feet to the true point of beginning,

a plat of which said property is attached hereto and made a part hereof as though described herein.

SECTION 2. That the real property herein described shall be designated as the **JOHNSON ADDITION TO THE City of Stilwell, Oklahoma**, and boundaries of said City are herewith changed to correspond to the legal description first above given.

SECTION 3. That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4. WHEREAS, an immediate necessity exists; therefore, for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist by reason whereof this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
