

ORDINANCE NO. 149

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 2 AND ORDINANCE NO. 8 OF THE CITY OF STILWELL, OKLAHOMA.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF STILWELL, OKLAHOMA:

That Ordinance No. 2, styled "an Ordinance to regulate the levying and tax upon certain specified occupations," and Ordinance No. 8, styled "an Ordinance reenacting Ordinance No. 2, regulating the levying collection of a tax on certain specified occupations and repealing the sixth paragraph thereof pertaining to penalties and reenacting the same," be and both of said Ordinances are hereby repealed in their entirety, and that all such occupation taxes as may or might be due and payable at the time of the passage of this Ordinance be and the same are hereby cancelled.

For the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, and emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately from and after its passage, approval and publication.
