

ORDINANCE NO. 223

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE ANNEXATION OF CERTAIN PROPERTY TO THE CITY OF STILWELL, OKLAHOMA, AND DESIGNATING SUCH TERRITORY AS THE RE-PLAT OF BRUNER ADDITION TO THE CITY OF STILWELL, OKLAHOMA.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the City of Stilwell, Oklahoma:

SECTION 1. That the following described real property situated in the present corporate limits of the City of Stilwell, Oklahoma, shall be annexed to and become part of the City of Stilwell, Oklahoma, to-wit:

Lots 1 through 8, re-plat of Bruner Addition, more particularly described as follows: Beginning at the Northwest corner of the NW NE, Section 34, Township 16 North, Range 25 East, Stilwell, Adair County, Oklahoma; thence S.00 degrees 00'00"W., along the West line of said NW NE, 396.00 feet; thence S.89 degrees 46'31"E., 164.81 feet; thence N.00 degrees 00'00"E., 250.00 feet; thence.89 degrees 46'31"E., 139.81 feet; thence N.00 degrees 00'00"E., 146.00 feet to the North line of said NW NE, thence N.89 degrees 46'31"W. along the North line 304.62 feet to a point of beginning, containing 1.97 acres more or less

a plat of which said property is attached hereto and made a part hereof as though described herein.

SECTION 2 That the real property herein described shall be designated as the **RE-PLAT OF BRUNER ADDITION** to the City of Stilwell, Oklahoma, and the boundaries of said City are hereby changed to correspond to the legal description first above given.

SECTION 3. That all ordinances, or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4. WHEREAS, an immediate necessity exists therefor, for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist by reason whereof this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
