ORDINANCE NO. 248

AN ORDINANCE CHANGING BOUNDARY LINES OF WARDS WITHIN CITY OF STILWELL IN ACCORDANCE WITH 11 O.S. 1991. SECTION 20-101 ET. SEQ., AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the City Council of Stilwell;

SECTION 1. In order to conform to statutes of the State of Oklahoma requiring alteration of ward boundaries as soon as practicable following each federal census so that the wards are formed of compact and centigous territory and are substantially equal in population the boundaries of said wards are, from and after the effective date of this ordinance altered as follows:

WARD 1:

All that part of the City of Stilwell lying East of 5th Street, North of Willow Street, East of 4th Street, North of Ash Street, West of 2nd Street, South of Hickory Street extended East to 2nd, East to Caney Creek, North of Cedar Street, West of 1st Street, North of Elm Street, West of Front Street from Elm to Ash.

WARD 2:

All that part of the City of Stilwell lying and being South of Cemetery Road and South of Doyle Street, West of 4th Street, South of Ash and South of Willow Street, West of 2nd Street, North of Hickory Street extended East to 2nd Street, East of Caney Creek.

WARD 3:

All that part of the City of Stilwell lying and being North of Cemetery Road and North of Doyle Street and West of 5th Street extended South to Doyle Street.

WARD 4:

All that part of the City of Stilwell lying and being South of Young Street, East of 3rd Street, South of Cedar Street, East of 1st Street, South of Elm Street, East of Front Street and South of Ash extended East.

WARD 5:

All that part of the City of Stilwell lying and being North of Young Street, West of 3rd Street, South of Cedar Street, West of Caney Creek, south of Cemetery Road.

 $\,$ SECTION 2. Members of the council shall be elected one from each ward as now provided by Charter.

SECTION 3. WHEREAS, an immediate necessity exists, therefore, for the preservation to the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, therefore, this ordinance shall take effect from and after is passage, approval, and publication.
