

ORDINANCE NO. 251

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE ANNEXATION OF CERTAIN PROPERTY TO THE CITY OF STILWELL, OKLAHOMA, AND CHANGING THE CITY'S BOUNDARY TO INCLUDE SUCH TERRITORY AND DESIGNATING SUCH TERRITORY AS THE 1993 ADDITION TO THE CITY OF STILWELL, OKLAHOMA; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Mayor and Council of the City of Stilwell, Oklahoma:

SECTION 1. That the following described real property situate adjacent to and abutting upon the present corporate limits of the City of Stilwell, Oklahoma, shall be annexed to and become part of the City of Stilwell, Oklahoma, to-wit:

A tract of land containing 74.73 acres, more or less, located in the N/2 of Section 35, Township 16 North, Range 25 East, I.B.&M., described as beginning at the N/4 corner of said Section 35; thence N.89 degrees 54' E along the North line thereof a distance of 1320.88 feet to the NE corner of the NW/4 NE/4 of said Section 35; thence South along the East line of the NW/4 NE/4 of said Section 35 a distance of 1320.00 feet to the SE corner of the NW/4 NE/4 of said Section 35; thence S.89 degrees 54' W along the South line of the N/2 N/2 of said Section 35 a distance of 2276.51 feet to the East right-of-way of the Kansas City Southern Railroad; thence N.17 degrees 49'58" W along said right-of-way a distance of 1385.84 feet to a point on the North line of said Section 35; thence N.89 degrees 54' E along said North line a distance of 481.50 feet; thence South a distance of 175.00 feet; thence N.89 degrees 54' E a distance of 172.53 feet; thence North a distance of 175.00 feet to a point on the North line of said Section 35; thence N. 89 degrees 54' E along the North line of said Section 35 a distance of 726.00 feet to the point of beginning

a plat of which said property is attached hereto and made a part hereof as though described herein.

SECTION 2. That the real property herein described shall be designated as the **1993 ADDITION** to the City of Stilwell, Oklahoma, and the boundaries of said City are hereby changed to correspond to the legal description first above given.

SECTION 3. That all ordinances, parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4. WHEREAS, an immediate necessity exists therefor, for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist by reason whereof this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
