

ORDINANCE NO. 275

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE ANNEXATION OF CERTAIN PROPERTY TO THE CITY OF STILWELL, OKLAHOMA, AND CHANGING THE CITY'S BOUNDARY TO INCLUDE SUCH TERRITORY AND DESIGNATING SUCH TERRITORY AS THE WATER PLANT ADDITION TO THE CITY OF STILWELL, OKLAHOMA; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Mayor and Council of the City of Stilwell, Oklahoma:

SECTION 1. That the following described real property situate adjacent to and abutting upon the present corporate limits of the City of Stilwell, Oklahoma, shall be annexed to and become part of the City of Stilwell, Oklahoma, to-wit:

A tract of land containing 29.73 acres more or less, located in the SW SE of Section 3, Township 15 North, Range 25 East, I.B.&M., Adair County, Oklahoma, described as follows: Beginning at the S/4 corner of said Section 3; thence North 00 degrees 15'56" East a distance of 657.58 feet along the West line of the SW SW SE of said Section 3 to the North line of said SW SW SE; thence South 89 degrees 56'17" East a distance of 756.93 feet along said North line to the SW corner of the NE SW SE of said Section 3; thence North 00 degrees 17'15" East a distance of 657.26 feet along the West line of said NE SW SE to the North line of said NE SW SE; thence South 89 degrees 54'36" East a distance of 657.18 feet along said North line to the East line of SW SE of said Section 3; thence South 00 degrees 18'34" West a distance of 1313.88 feet along said East line to the South line of said Section 3; thence North 89 degrees 57'57" West a distance of 1313.36 feet to the point of beginning

a plat of which said property is attached hereto and made a part hereof as though described herein.

SECTION 2. That the real property herein described shall be designated as the **WATER PLANT ADDITION** to the City of Stilwell, Oklahoma, and the boundaries of said City are hereby changed to correspond to the legal description first above given.

SECTION 3. That all ordinances, parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4. WHEREAS, an immediate necessity exists therefor, for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist by reason whereof this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
