

ORDINANCE NO. 96

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR: A PENALTY FOR RIDING A MOTORCYCLE, MOTOR-SCOOTER OR MOTOR-BICYCLE WITHOUT ADEQUATE SAFETY HELMET, AND FROM CARRYING PASSENGERS THEREON WITH CERTAIN EXCEPTIONS:

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Mayor and Council of the City of Stilwell, Oklahoma:

SECTION 1. That it shall be unlawful for any person to ride a Motorcycle, Motorscooter or a motor-bicycle within the City of Stilwell, Oklahoma unless said person shall wear a safety helmet.

SECTION 2. That it shall be unlawful for any person to drive a Motorcycle, Motor-Scooter or a Motor-Bicycle while transporting more than one passenger, except a Motorcycle, Motor-Scooter or a Motor-Bicycle factory designed for the purpose of carrying additional passengers.

SECTION 3. That anyone convicted of the above set out offenses shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$35.00 and costs which shall be taxed in the sum of \$5.00 additional dollars.

SECTION 4. That all Ordinances, and parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 5. WHEREAS, an immediate necessity exists, therefore, for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist by reason whereof this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after it's passage and approval.


